IRWIN warrants to the original owner that this product is free from defects in material and workmanship for its reasonable useful life. IRWIN MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, CONCERNING THE PRODUCT OR THE MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS THEREOF FOR ANY PURPOSE.

DEFINITION OF A VALID DEFECT:

A valid defect is defined by a failure of a new and unaltered tool to perform its intended function, when subjected to the normal and customary application for which the tool was designed.

DEFINITION OF NORMAL WEAR AND TEAR, NOT COVERED UNDER WARRANTY-

Wear and tear on our cutting tools is expected as they proceed through their useful life. Such wear and tear is normal, and is therefore not covered under our Limited Lifetime Warranty. Worn or dull cutting edges, worn, flutes and extractor teeth, breakage of any tap, extractor, or drill bit, below 1/4" in diameter, and discoloration from use do not qualify a tool for warranty. Aftermarket sharpening of any tool immediately disqualifies that tool from coverage under our Limited Warranty.

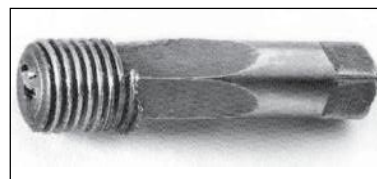
DEFINITION OF ABUSE, NOT COVERED UNDER WARRANTY-

This warranty does not apply to product that has been damaged as a result of improper maintenance, accident, or other misuse. Products that are repaired or modified in any way by anyone other than IRWIN do not qualify for coverage under this warranty. In no event shall IRWIN be liable for incidental or consequential damages resulting from misuse or alteration of our products.

SOME, BUT NOT ALL EXAMPLES OF ABUSE OR MISUSE, NOT COVERED UNDER WARRANTY ARE:

- Flattened point on a bit indicating a hammer drill was used.
- Breakage or dulling of taps or dies resulting from use without cutting fluid.
- Breakage or dulling of drill bit from use without cutting fluid.
- Use of tap or die in a power tool.
- Physical alteration of any tool by anyone other than the manufacturer.
- Drill tip breakage due to higher than recommended feed pressure.
- Breakage of any tap, extractor, or drill bit below 1/4" in diameter.

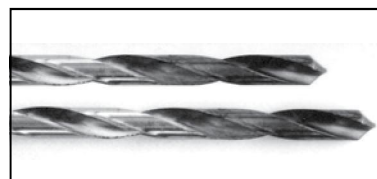
